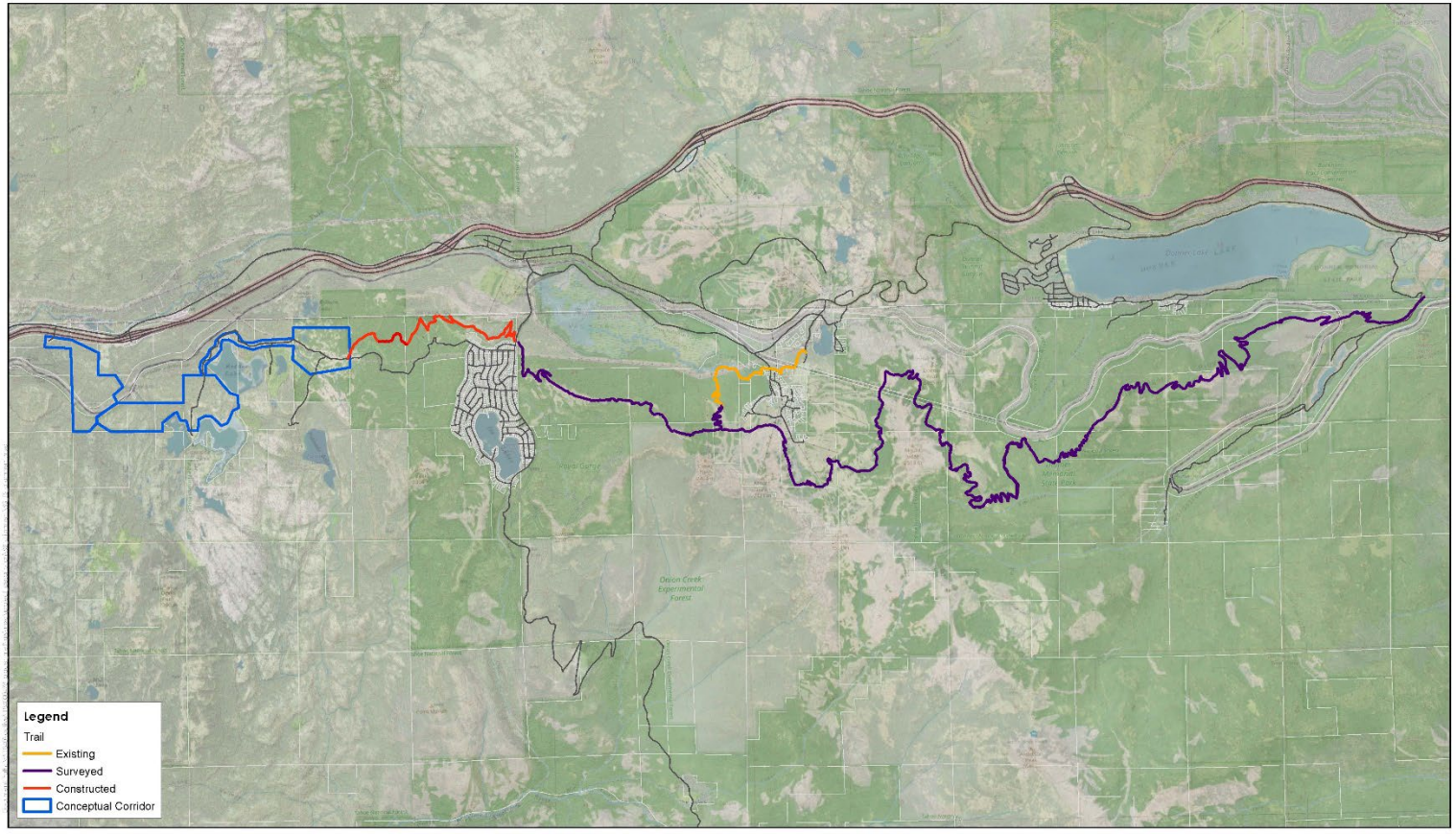

Memorial Overland Emigrant Trail Project

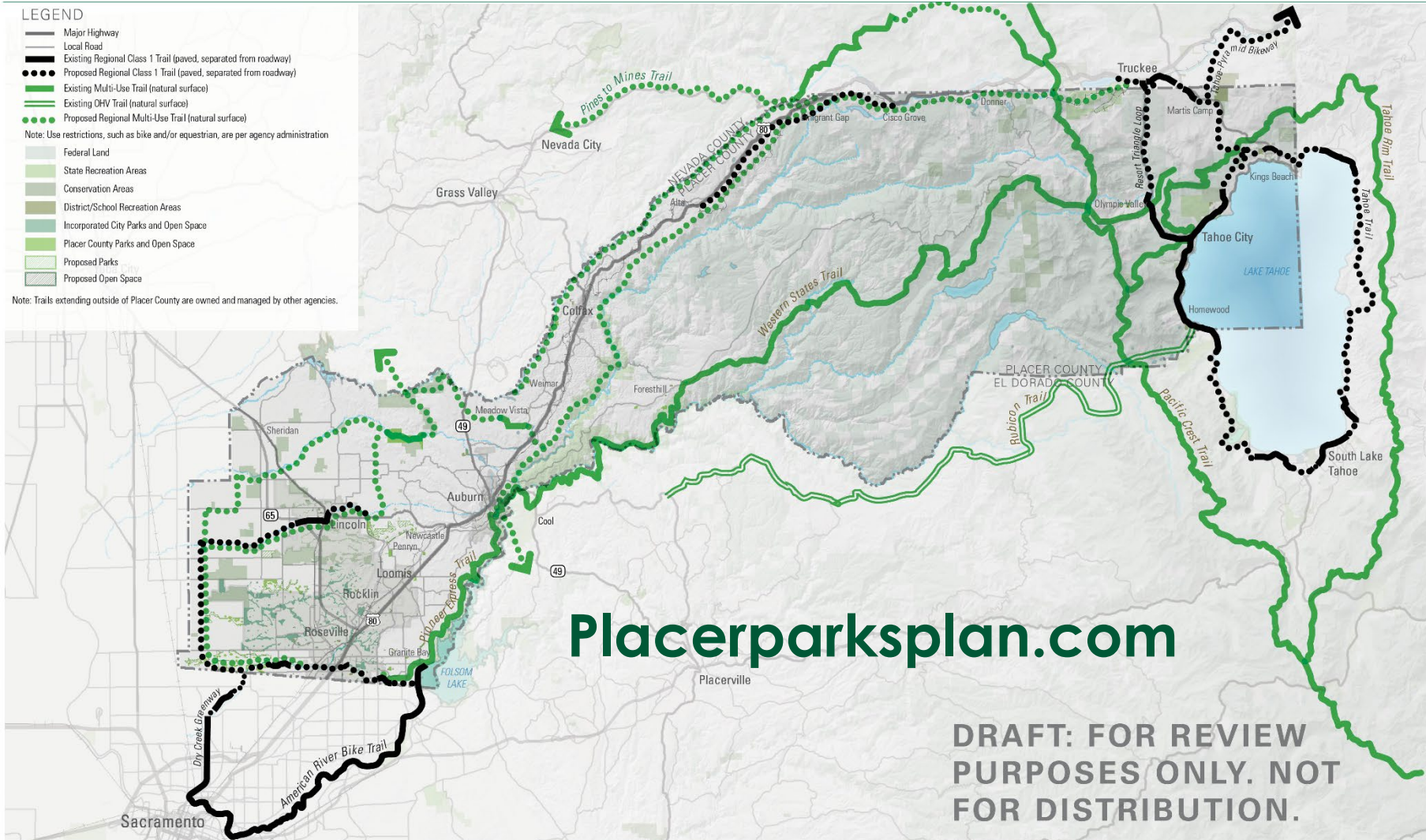


Placer County Park & Trail Master Plan

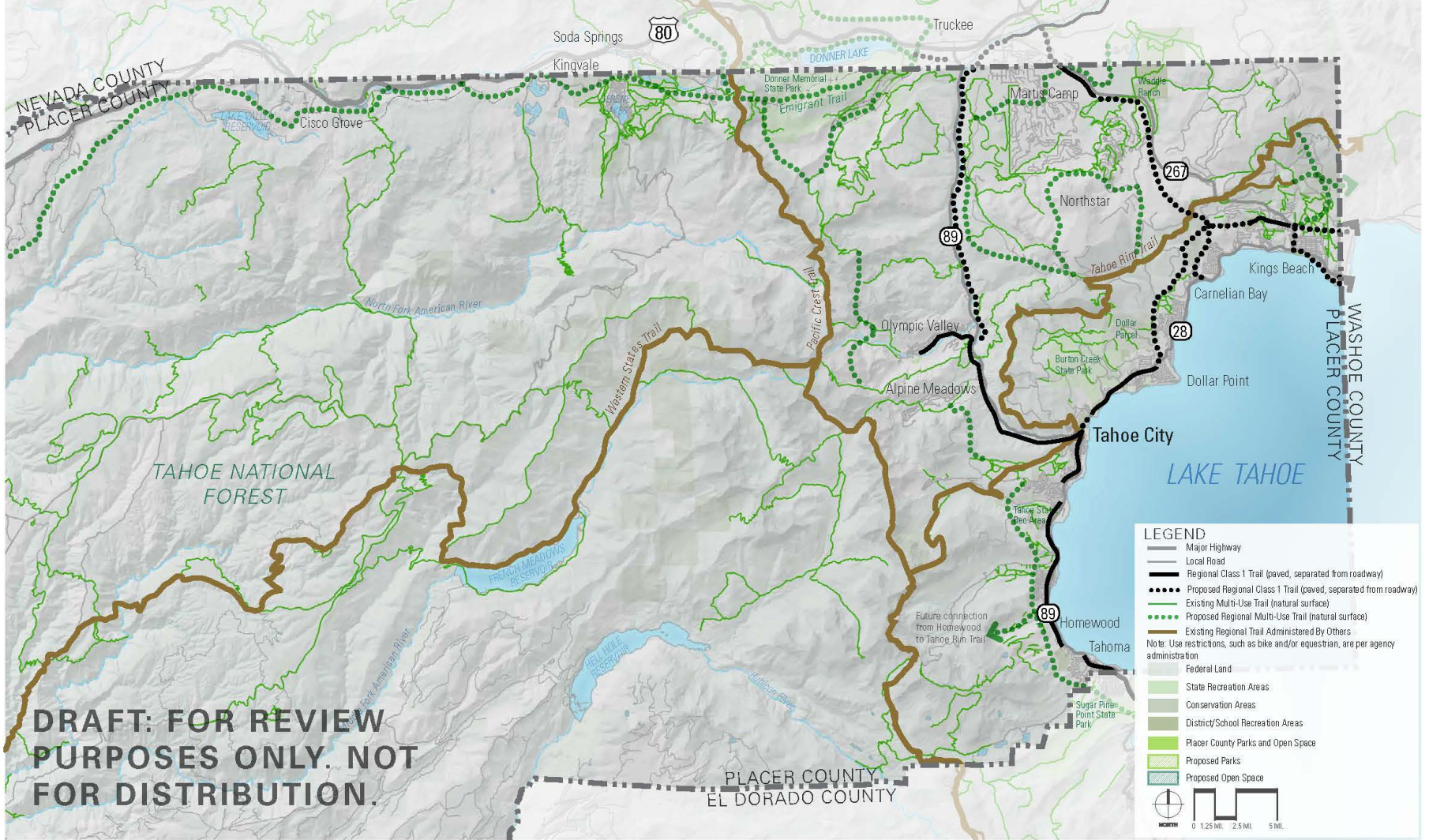

FY 2021-22 Grant Cycle Timeline

Please note this schedule is tentative.

August 31, 2021	Application Release
October 14, 2021, at 5 p.m.	Complete project proposals due
October 19, 2021	Chair and Vice-Chair application review
October 28, 2021	CAP Committee grant application review
November 09, 2021	Applicant interviews
November 18, 2021	Committee Deliberation/Recommendation
December 16, 2021	CAP Committee recommendations to Placer County Board of Supervisors
January-February 2022	Placer County staff prepares grant agreements for approved projects

*Note - Projects approved for this grant cycle will not receive funding until after Placer County Board of Supervisors approval and execution of a grant agreement between Placer County and grantee.
